WaterSense Labeled Toilet Rebate Application Existing Single-Family Residential Rebate

July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2017

Rebate Availability

Rebates are available only for EXISTING single-family residential homes. WCWCD rebate program may be subject to change or modification at any time. Replacement toilets must be new, must be purchased and installed prior to submitting a rebate application and must have been purchased and installed after July 1, 2014. Applications must include all information requested. Failure to provide this information may result in the delay or denial of the rebate.

Rebate Qualification

PLEASE NOTE: Program is offered to any resident in Washington County. However, if City of St. George is your water provider, please visit sgcity.org to apply for its rebate. **This rebate cannot be combined with the toilet rebate offered by City of St. George.** This program offers a rebate for replacement on 2000 or older (pre-2000) model toilet with a WaterSense labeled toilet. A list of toilets which qualify for the rebate can be found on the EPA's WaterSense website: <http://www.epa.gov/watersense>. This program will run from July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2017 or until funds are depleted, whichever occurs first. If the County Assessor lists the home as built in 2000 or older, applicant is eligible for the rebate.

 - Retailer name and address
 - Item number of the WaterSense Labeled toilet(s) purchased
 - Signed** application

I understand that submission of this application DOES NOT relieve me of my obligation to pay my utility account on time and in full while waiting for the rebate to be processed.

Rebate Verification

Applications are subject to verification by WCWCD. If your application is selected for verification, it will not be processed until the verification process is satisfactorily completed. Rebates will be paid in the form of a credit issued on the utility account. The exception to payment in the form of a credit on the utility bill will be made for a landlord making improvements to a single-family residence that is a rental unit or an applicant who pays for water through an HOA and does not have a public utility bill.

WCWCD is not responsible if your retailer or contractor provides inaccurate information about the amount and/or conditions of the actual rebate and for fixtures that are mislabeled or misrepresented by dealers regarding rebate qualifications.

Rebate Limitations and Limitation of damages

Payment of the rebate by WCWCD does not warrant the performance of qualifying/installed replacement toilet and does not guarantee any specified amount of water or cost savings. The customer shall independently evaluate any information related to the qualifying toilet.
