About Red Hills Desert Garden

Red Hills Desert Garden, Utah's first desert conservation garden, is located on 4.5-acres along the northern rim of St. George. The garden features more than 5,000 water-efficient plants, a 1,150-foot meandering stream and fish viewing area stocked with native and endangered species from the Virgin River, prehistoric dinosaur tracks, and a replica slot canyon that pays tribute to Southern Utah's natural landscape. The garden, which opened to the public in 2015, is a collaborative project of the Washington County Water Conservancy District, City of St. George and Virgin River Program.
