Meeting called to order by Mayor Lefevre at 3 p.m.

1. Equitable water allocations.
  - a. Complaints on 2 days a week watering times makes it impossible to get across the field in the sets that have to be moved. The solid seems to make the best of the situation.

**Conversation about Lowe's Complaints:** Loren spoke about 30 acres of field to be watered, not in solid sets, one of the larger if not the largest, has 6 AF of water. Ron interrupted to 6 AF if it is there, but when there is shortage then everyone needs to take the cuts. Loren continued, not many solid sets on 40 acres. Crop determines type of irrigation possible. Solid sets may be able to work with restrictions, but the wheel line is impossible to get across the field in a week. Loren recommended to allow us to water as we need to using the allotted water.

Ron can't take it whenever you want because the system doesn't have the capability to allow that. Than made two points (1) people with set lines can turn on all at once and that isn't true, users don't have the pressure to allow that. (2) harvest is also a part their management, and when there are solid sets, a part of the hay around the sprinkler set is missed. The users with solid sets have to break up the field also. Dave said he did half a crop of what he could do. Anita said that she sacrificed quite a bit of crop and Than said that everyone has.

Loren is interested in getting metered to show their water use. Loren asked if there were too many people on the system. Ron said no system problems, it's the springs problem. Anita wanted to run an experiment. A proposal was suggested to have the Lowe's take the water on Sunday. Same hours except all on Sunday. Ron said to accommodate the Lowes experiment as long as it didn't hurt other users. The schedule can only be flexible on Sunday since Sunday has been a recover day. Darrin wanted to know if the recommendation workable. The Lowe's said no. Ron said as long as it doesn't hurt other users.

Nothing resolved.
