1. Ag users and equitable water allocation.

Lowe's want to change their schedule. Use the same amount of water, but just be allowed to water every day. The board discussed their type of system, when purchasing water rights, they had more acreage than turned in for the water rights. They have five 4-inch connections.

Points brought out in the discussion:

- No one else on the system is watering more than 10 acres.
- We have already finalized the ag zones to allow for pressure, giving him his proposal will mess up other users.
- No one can water their fields all at once
- Discussed the pond on the property, this is illegal (Dave will verify with the field crew)
- Lowe's need to take the cuts on use as everyone else.
- Lowe's are coming from a point of view that isn't correct
- Meters on now and the use needs to be averaged
- changing the schedule will cause issues for other ag users
- He is already pretty much alone on that lower area
- Complaints also come from little lots, get the same time as the larger lots

The board denied the Lowe request. The board concluded:

- A zone was set up that has minimal use from other water users while the Lowe's are watering to give them maximum pressure.
- They can't set up a special situation/treatment different from all other water users.
- There is a water scarcity issue and all users need to share the shortage.
- With the installation of the new meters, there isn't enough data to permit this special request nor is there the ability to currently monitor the times of water use.

2. Other issues discussed:

Gilbert's watering enough to have it run off into Ty's yard. The board requested to have a letter written.

Next meeting is the public hearing, August 11 at 4 p.m.
